To Degree Programs

The Banff Centre Arts programs are not designed to meet particular equivalence requirements of the degree-granting institutions but some Centre programs may meet requirements of a post-secondary and/or graduate-level educational experience and are acceptable where appropriate for credit. Upon presentation of transcripts, an audition and/or adjudication of a body of creative work¹, Alberta universities and private colleges with accredited degree programs will consider the award of advance credit in appropriate degree programs for students who have successfully completed programs of not less than 3 weeks duration at The Banff Centre.

The Centre offers the following programs which may be acceptable for credit:

BANFF NEW MEDIA INSTITUTE – Co-Productions Residencies (4 weeks); Banff New Media Institute Workshops and Summits (3 days - 4 weeks); Work Study programs (2 - 12 months).

VISUAL ARTS – Thematic Residencies (7 weeks); New Works (7 weeks); Aboriginal New Works (7 weeks); Self-Directed Residencies (3 weeks - 8 months); Co-Productions: Television, Interactive Media, Multi-Media, Research (duration determined by parameters of individual proposals); Work Study programs Level 1 (3 months to 1 year), Level 2 (3 weeks to 2 years); Banff New Media Institute (3 weeks); Aboriginal Arts (duration determined by parameters of individual proposals); Banff International Curatorial Institute Work Study (3 - 6 months).

CREATIVE ELECTRONIC ENVIRONMENT – Work Study programs levels 2 and 3 (3 weeks - 2 years).

THEATRE PRODUCTION, DESIGN & STAGE MANAGEMENT – Work Study programs (6-20 weeks).

LITERARY ARTS – Writing Studio Prose/Poetry (5 weeks); Playwrights Colony (3 weeks); Creative Non-fiction & Cultural Journalism (4 weeks).

PERFORMING ARTS – Dance: Training (5 weeks); Professional (6 weeks); Opera Training and Professional programs (8 weeks); Assistantships (8 weeks); Arts Administration Work Study Program (10-24 weeks).

MUSIC & SOUND – Career Development Residencies (12 weeks); Chamber Music (3 weeks); Short-term Residencies (3-4 weeks); Winds Master Classes (3 weeks); Strings Master Classes (3 weeks); Keyboard Festival (3 weeks); Workshop in Jazz and Creative Music (3 weeks); Jazz Orchestra (1 week); Audio Associates (12-14 weeks); Audio Assistants (12-14 weeks).

ABORIGINAL ARTS – For 2006-2007, programs are to be announced.
